He writes the secular parenting blog *The Meming of Life*, and teaches humanist parenting seminars across the United States. In September 2008 he was named Harvard Humanist of the Year by the Humanist Chaplaincy at Harvard University. Dale holds degrees in physical anthropology and music theory from UC Berkeley as well as a Ph.D. in composition from the University of Minnesota.
